Room sizes corresponding to chandelier sizes

Finding the proper suitable diameter of a chandelier

This table gives chandelier diameter corresponding to specific room sizes. The labels "small" and "large" refer to the perceived size of the chandelier relative to the room. For historic settings select near the "small" diameter. For modern settings, choose "large".

Adjust towards smaller size for massive and dominant chandeliers. Some chandeliers such as Hoffmann's 41085-22-Cologne has a strong presence thus choose the ratio rather towards small. Other chandeliers like the 4636-Schloss Hof-series are rather transparent so one can select larger items of such styles.

With some chandeliers we can adjust the height relative to the diameter to fit low ceilings. But with most design the ratio is a firm number based on the design.
