



Chandelier Suspensions

Standard Types

Suspensions in detail (from left to right):

Rod: Simplest and most gentle suspension. All wires are inside the pipe. It comes in a finish matching the chandelier and cannot be adjusted on site.

Chain: Easiest way when it is necessary to adjust the height on site and comes in a finish matching the chandelier. Wires are threaded through the links and become a stylistic element.

Silk Rope: All technical elements such as a steel rope and the wires are covered by silk. This allows adjustment on site by about 5 cm. Available in various colours.

Chandelier Hose: This is a piece of silk or other fabric that conceals an otherwise plain suspension of steel chain or wire. It is either a kind of scarf wrapped around the suspension or a custom-made hose. Colour and texture can be matched with existing curtains or upholstery or the like.
